GROUND Entry is via gate 3, Racehorse Rd, Clarendon and must be prior to 8.00am.

- WRIST BANDS:** The Participant Risk Acknowledgement & Waiver form must be completed and presented to the registration desk at the alpaca section. The steward collecting the forms will apply a wrist band to all handlers of alpacas. Anyone leading an alpaca will NOT be permitted into the Showring or the Grand Parade.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. The HDAA General regulations form part of the conditions of entry. In the event of any inconsistency, and provided there is no constitutional conflict, the general regulations of the Australian Alpaca Association Ltd will prevail. Exhibitors should refer to the AAA Showing Rules Manual 2018.
2. AGE GROUPS - age classification shall be as at the day of the Show – e.g. an animal that turns 12 months old on the day of the Show would be entered in the 12 - 18 months class.
3. Handlers must wear white dustcoats, display wrist bands and have exhibit numbers clearly displayed in an arm band on the left arm in the Judging Ring and the Grand Parade.
